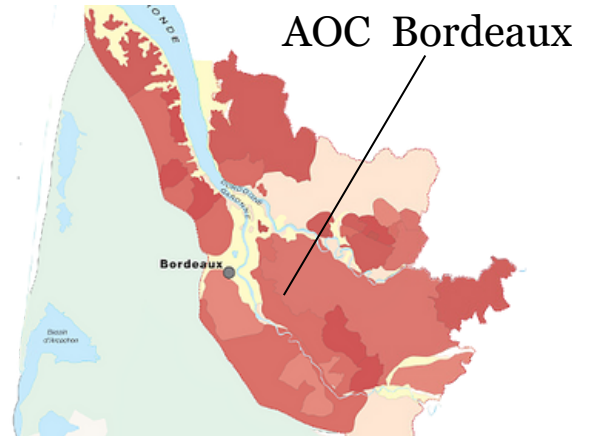


Château Plaisance

A subtle herbal aroma emerges from the red berry notes, adding a delicate layer of complexity to the wine. This wine combines the complex traits of black fruits and spices, revealing a rich fruity flavor on the palate that is vibrant and accompanied by velvety powdery tannins, exuding a bright quality.
