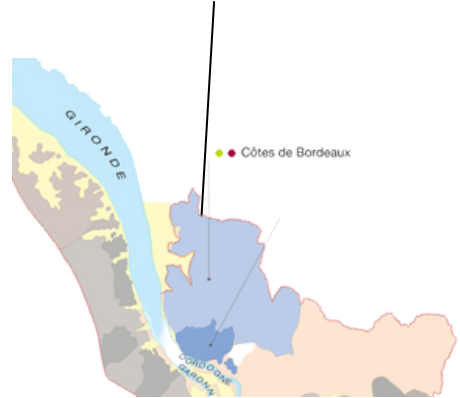


Château Plaisance
