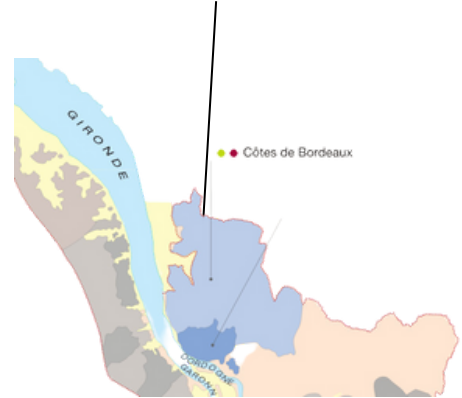


Château Plaisance
